


#### ORDINAL NUMBERS (USED FOR POSITIONING) THESE NUMBERS INDICATE THE POSITION OF SOMETHING IN A SEQUENCE (E.G., FIRST, SECOND, THIRD).

**1ST – KÌÍNÍ** 2ND – KÈJÌ 3RD - KETA 4TH – KERIN 5TH – KÀRÚN 6TH – KEFÀ 7TH – KEJE 8TH – KĘJO 9TH – KĘSÁN 10TH – KEWÀÁ 20TH – KEGÚN 30TH – KĘGBÓN 40TH – KEGÓJÌ 50TH – KEDÓTA 100TH – KEGÓRÙN-ÚN



Yorùbá cardinal number convey the "how many" they're also known as "counting numbers," because they show quantity. Here are some examples:
