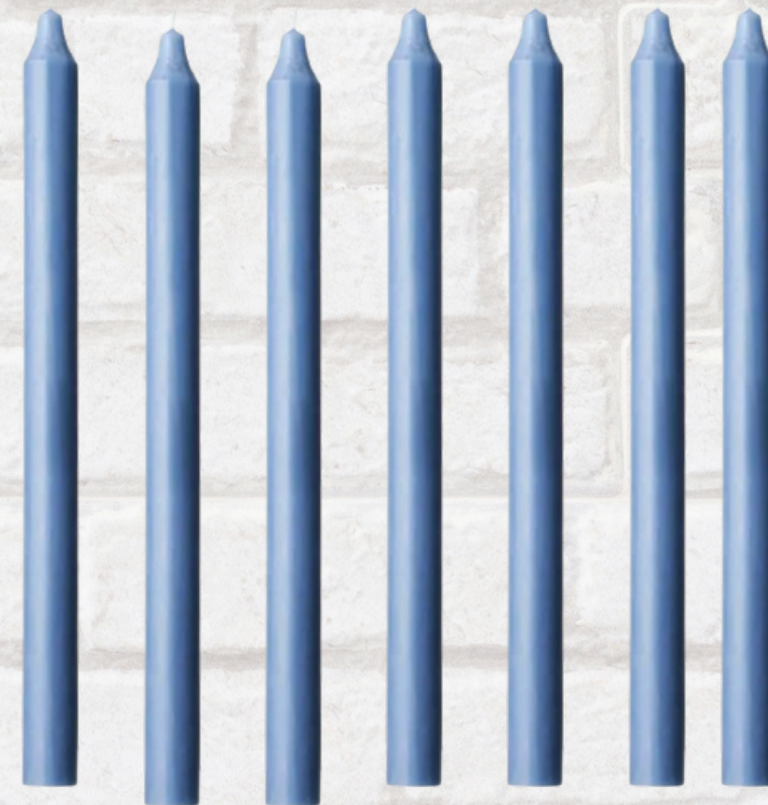

Cardinal numbers in Yorùbá

Grade Level: Children

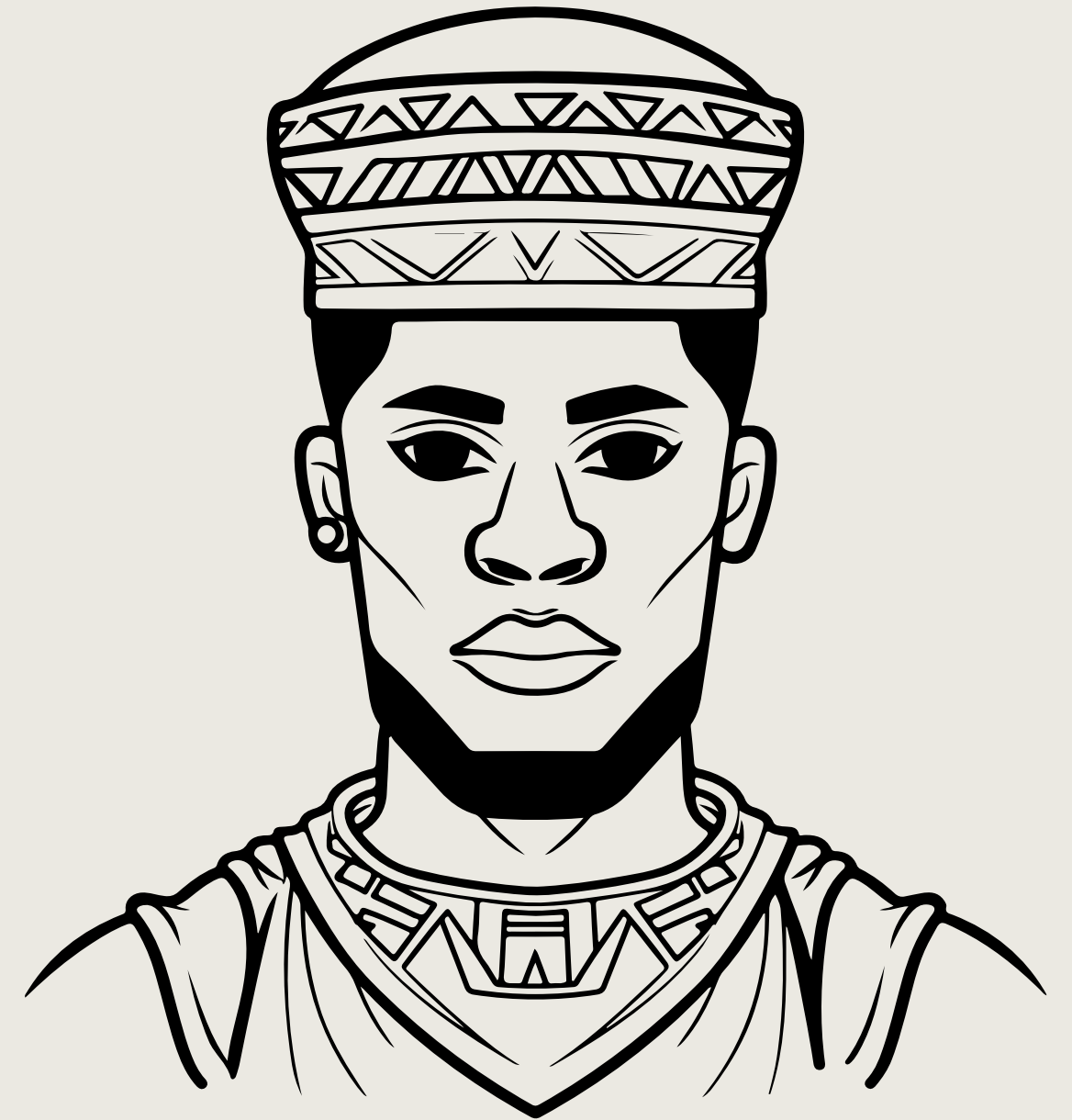
Objective: Be able to recognize and correctly pronounce Yorùbá cardinal numbers, use them in simple sentences, and understand their significance in counting objects.

Here are the Cardinal and Ordinal Yoruba numbers:

Cardinal Numbers (Used for Counting)

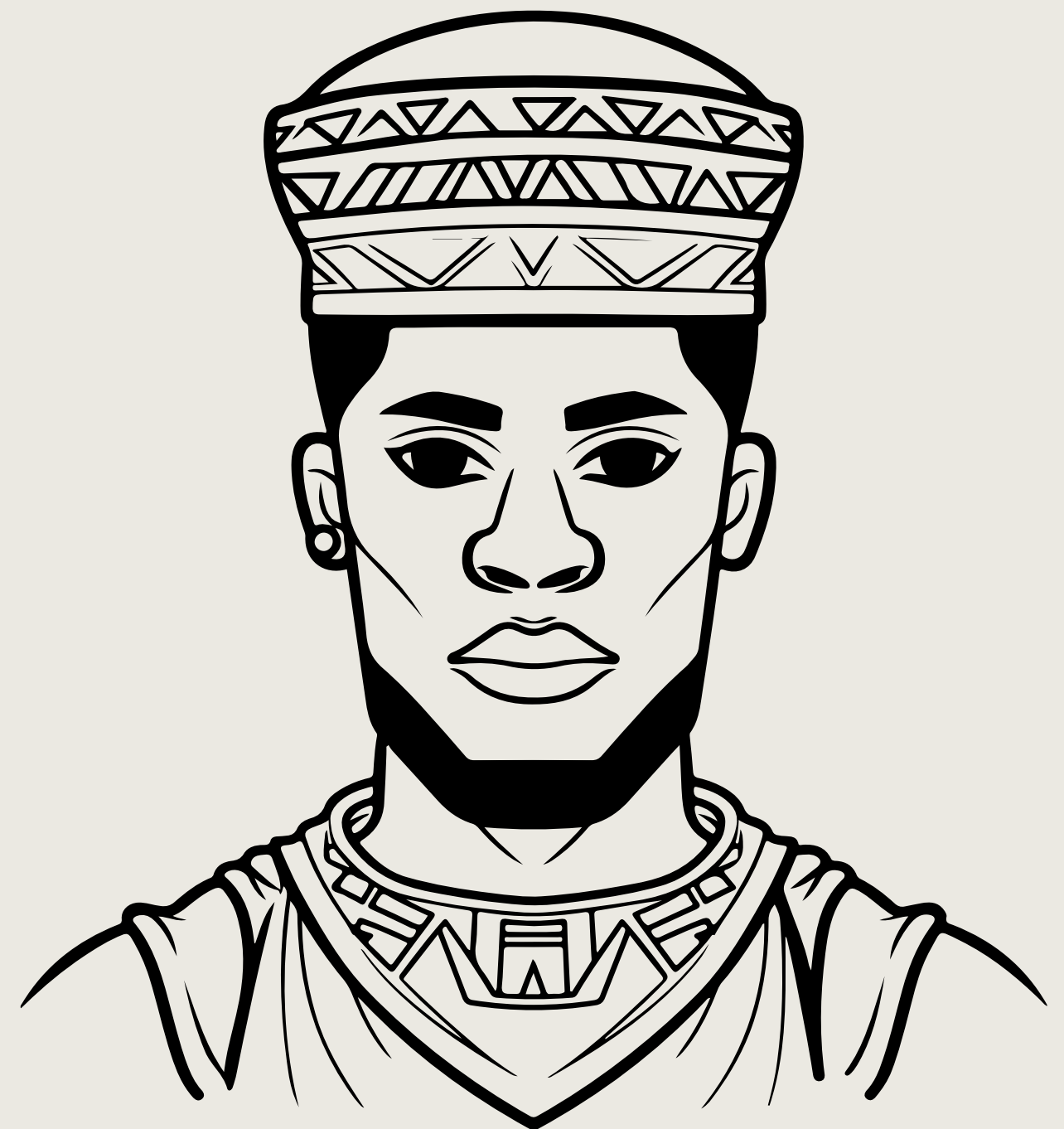
These are numbers used for counting objects, people, or things.

- 1 – Ọkan
- 2 – Mèjì
- 3 – Mèta
- 4 – Mèrin
- 5 – Màrùn-ún
- 6 – Mèfà
- 7 – Mèje
- 8 – Mèjọ
- 9 – Mèsán
- 10 – Mèwàá
- 20 – Ogún
- 30 – Ọgbọn
- 40 – Ogójì
- 50 – Àádọta
- 60 – Ogójì
- 70 – Àádọrin
- 80 – Ọgọrin
- 90 – Àádọrún
- 100 – Ọgọrùn-ún



ORDINAL NUMBERS (USED FOR POSITIONING) THESE NUMBERS INDICATE THE POSITION OF SOMETHING IN A SEQUENCE (E.G., FIRST, SECOND, THIRD).

1ST – KÌÍNÍ
2ND – KÈJÌ
3RD – KÈTA
4TH – KÈRIN
5TH – KÀRÚN
6TH – KÈFÀ
7TH – KÈJE
8TH – KÈJO
9TH – KÈSÀN
10TH – KÈWÀÁ
20TH – KÈGÚN
30TH – KÈGBÒN
40TH – KÈGÓJÌ
50TH – KÈDÓTA
100TH – KÈGÓRÙN-ÚN

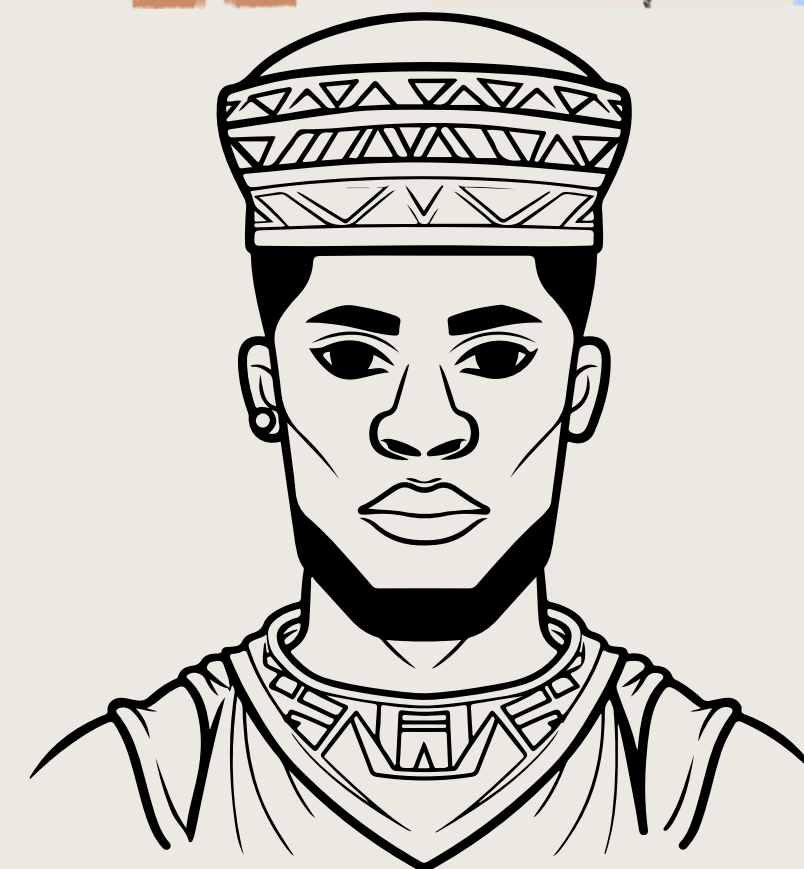


Yorùbá cardinal number convey the “how many” they’re also known as “counting numbers,” because they show quantity.

Here are some examples:

Five pens	–	Gègé márùn
Six books	–	Ìwé mẹfà
Two cows	–	Màálù méjì

Zero	òfo	oh-foe
One	kan	con
Two	(m)éjì	may-jee
Three	mẹta	meh-tah
Four	mẹrin	meh-reen
Five	márùn	mah-roon
Six	mẹfà	meh-fah
Seven	méje	may-jay
Eight	mẹjọ	meh-jor
Nine	mẹsàn	meh-son
Ten	mẹwàá	meh-wah
